The Summer School will be a **7 days** residential and intensive course, for a total amount of **60 hours**. Thirty places are available for **30 graduate** students, researchers and practitioners, 5 of which from developing countries.

The Summer School will give participants useful tools and methodologies to:

- increase awareness of human rights and international protection instruments;
- analyse and manage the processes of peaceful resolution of conflicts;
- develop scientific skills in the field of human rights research and communication;
- understand and manage projects in human rights education, development cooperation and humanitarian aid.

The cost will be € 400,00, including accommodation, board and tuition (excluding travel expenses). The fee will be waived for **5 applicants from developing countries**, including travel expenses of a maximum of € 500,00 per person.

Applications (motivational letter and CV) must be submitted by e-mail to **cirps.formazione@uniroma1.it**. Fluency in oral and written English is required.

Deadline for applications is **8 June 2009**.
